# Green Leaf Park

Visitors to Green Leaf Park would never know that this land was once a gravel pit. It is the first site to be developed and opened as a county park featuring grassy slopes, a wooded nature trail, and large wetland.

Green Leaf Park's 62 acres provide many amenities for you to enjoy including the early 1800s Hard-Wilson log house – one of the earliest homes known to exist in Medina County. This structure was moved to the park by the Sharon Historical Society. The Medina County Herb Society maintains a herb garden near the cabin.

A small fishing pond is located at the park, and the hill overlooking the fields is a favorite spot for sledding in the winter. There is also a shelter and individual picnic tables.

Take a stroll on the nature trail. Visit Green Leaf in the spring and hear the chorus of spring peepers found in the park's wetland. During all seasons, there is something to appreciate at Green Leaf Park.
