Trekking through Autumn is a self-guided hiking program that allows you to get out and explore your Medina County parks. Participants who hike eight or more of the designated trails (listed on back) will receive an award. Park locations can be found at www.medinacountyparks.com.

Hikes must be completed from September 1 through November 30. All parks are open from dawn until dark except Wolf Creek Environmental Center, which is open Tuesday-Saturday from 9-5 and Sunday 12-5.

First-year hikers earn a backpack, and veteran hikers earn a pin. Awards are free for all Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$2 for the hiking pins.

To claim your award, bring completed forms to Wolf Creek Environmental Center at 6100 Ridge Rd. (Rt. 94) in Sharon Center (if using a GPS, use Wadsworth). Deadline for receiving awards is **February 28, 2018**.

Form fields for Last Name, First Name, Address, City, State, Zip, Phone number, checkboxes for hiker status and residency, and signature lines.
