COVID-19 UPDATE

August 5, 2021

Masks - Effective August 9

In an effort to keep park staff, volunteers, and our extended family members safe from COVID-19 and its variants, masks are required for everyone (vaccinated and unvaccinated) entering Oenslager Nature Center, Susan Hambley Nature Center, and Park District Headquarters beginning Monday, August 9.

Masks will be optional outdoors in our parks and at public programs that take place outside. Regarding private events in the park district's reservable enclosed facilities, we highly recommend masks, but they will not be required by the park district.

Susan Hambley Nature Center

Susan Hambley Nature Center is open to the public on Saturday and Sunday from 12 to 5 p.m.

Programs

Masks will be optional at public programs that take place outside. At indoor public programs and events, masks will be required for everyone regardless of vaccination status.

Shelter Reservations

Through 2021, Medina County Park District reserves the right to charge permit holders for additional cleaning and disinfecting services if CDC and state health guidelines change regarding COVID-19. Regarding private events in the park district's reservable enclosed facilities, we highly recommend masks, but they will not be required by the park district.
