Killbuck Lakes Nature Preserve	Yes	Yes	No	No	There are 2.65 miles of dirt, grass, gravel, and boardwalk trails that loop around the park. The trails range in difficulty from easy to moderate.
Lodi Harrisville Historical Society	Yes	No	Yes	Yes	There is grass to traverse if you park in front of the building. There is pavement to traverse if you park on the street. There are four steps to go into the house and there is a second floor with additional exhibits.
Lodi Library	No	No	Yes	No	There are stairs from the overflow parking lot at the park across the street. The building is ADA accessible.
Lodi Railroad Museum	Yes	No	No	Yes	Three steps into Depot with a ramp on the east side.
Medina County Solid Waste District	No	No	Yes	No	Shuttle service will be provided between each facility for tours. Restrooms are available on ground flood of specialty waste building.

Northern Ohio Railway Museum	Yes	Yes	No	Yes	Visitors may either walk or ride a trolley car from the parking lot to the museum. All buildings have ramps and are wheelchair accessible. Trolley rides involve three to five steps depending on the type of car.
Pine Crest Farms	Yes	Yes	Yes	No	Parking will be on grass and gravel. The market and restrooms will be on gravel. The greenhouse has pavement. Accessible parking is in front of the market.
Rising Son Family Farm	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	There is one gravel driveway and one paved driveway. Most of the site is grass. There are three steps to the milk stand.
Spencer Historical Society	No	No	Yes	Yes	There is a ramp to access the building. The museum is located on the second floor. Though there is not a traditional elevator, there is access via an electric lift chair elevator.
Westfield Historical Society	No	Yes	Yes	Yes	The back parking lot is gravel and a few cars can park in front of the building where a ramp leads inside. There are 2 steps down to the bathroom.
