

Wolf Creek Environmental Center REOPENS on 7/6 with a new name!



During the COVID-19 shutdown, park staff took time to evaluate Wolf Creek Environmental Center's purpose and how it has evolved since its opening in 2000 as a youth-focused environmental center. Over time, the center has progressed into a nature center seeking to meet the needs of all user groups through nature displays, temporary exhibits, educational programs, and indoor bird-watching area. With this shift in focus, and coinciding with the reopening, is the dedication of the facility and wildlife sanctuary to Ruth Alderfer-Oenslager, who donated her 103 acres to Medina County Park District in 1975.
