Buckeye Woods Park

Buckeye Woods Park, being one of the largest parks in the system, encompasses approximately 392 acres of land. The park is named for the grove of Buckeye trees found along the stream in the Schleman Nature Preserve.

This site offers athletic fields for youth and adult sporting activities, a reservable picnic shelter, a three-acre lake, and two play structures. Also, various trails provide great places to walk for exercise or enjoyment.

Chippewa Inlet Trail

The 2.9-mile Chippewa Inlet Trail leads you from the north side of Buckeye Woods Park (at the State Route 42 parking lot) south to Chippewa Road.

On the north end of the Chippewa Inlet Trail, visitors will experience a variety of interesting habitats from an upland pine stand to wet woods and restored wetlands. The trail has a crushed limestone surface from the northernmost trailhead south to the athletic field area of the park. From this point south, the trail surface is asphalt. There is also a crushed limestone loop trail that circles the wetland restoration area.

The trail continues south across State Route 162. Visitors pass through a former peat mine area that is being restored to wetland habitat. A wide variety of flora and fauna can be found along the trail in the restoration area. Much of this area was historically covered by a bog forest. The trail ends at the trailhead located on Chippewa Road.

Schleman Nature Preserve

To the west, Schleman Nature Preserve, named for the family that donated the original acreage, offers wooded nature trails. At the request of the donors, no further development will take place at this site.
