

# MCPD 45th Anniversary - Plum Creek

Size:  (Regular) Difficulty:  Terrain:  (1 is easiest, 5 is hardest)

N 41° 12.541 W 081° 48.749

This cache is part of the [Medina County Parks 45th Anniversary Challenge](#). You do not have to participate in the challenge to do this cache, but we hope you will anyway!

[Plum Creek Park](#) is a beautiful park in northeastern Medina County. It has picnic areas, two reservable picnic pavilions, a reservable indoor shelter, a playground, 2 stocked fishing ponds and miles of paved and unpaved hiking trails. The park contains 230 acres, much of it reclaimed landfill, of shallow, wooded valleys traversed by small creeks. Yellow poplars and flowering dogwoods are among the many varieties of trees here.

A one mile round-trip hike will be required to get this cache. The cache can be accessed from the Plum Creek **South** parking lot, on Plum Creek Parkway in Brunswick Hills Township. A paved path leads from the back of the parking lot (coordinates listed below) past the playground and into the woods. Follow the paved path and watch for dirt trails branching off to the left. The trailheads are marked with waist-high wooden posts. You are looking for the second trail. You'll find it at a point where the paved trail makes a sharp turn to the right. Turn left onto the dirt trail and follow it into the woods, singing as you go:

Down in the valley, valley so low,  
See yonder footbridge, that's where you go!  
Cross the bridge over, then turn to the left,  
Don't turn too early or you'll get all wet!

Walk by the creekside, then turn to the right,  
Climb that ol' hill there; scaling the heights!  
Follow the trail now to a lone tree,  
Here the trail branches into a T.

Follow the "right" branch to three buried pipes,  
Then fifty more paces will put you in sight!  
Look to the right now, what do you see?  
You'll find the treasure in yon triple tree!

The cache, a medium sized lock-n-lock container, is located within 25 feet of the trail, so please do not bushwhack. Please remember to cache in and trash out. Park closes at dark.
