

WELCOME TO RIVER STYX PARK...



Fed by a unique aeration tower, the water quality at this pond is the best in the park system.

River Styx Park opened on May 18, 1996 and was named after the local community. It has 83.5 acres of land, a 3.6-acre pond (stocked with large mouth bass; blue gill; some channel cat fish; and, in the spring and fall, rainbow trout), a .75-mile wooded trail, and a .50-mile asphalt trail.

As erosion by a glacier and water shaped the meandering River Styx Valley, the upland ravines of this 83-acre site have become a quiet haven for flora and fauna.

Birdwatchers enjoy viewing the variety of birds that migrate to this park. At the grand opening of the park, over 60 species of birds were seen or heard by birdwatchers.

River Styx Park is one of the few remaining sites in the county where migrating neo-tropical songbirds are found. These visitors fly from the rain forests of Central America to stay in Medina County for the summer. This site has been studied by the Smithsonian Institute as part of its research on nesting sites for neo-tropicals. Known nesters

include the acadian flycatcher, wood thrush, yellow-throated vireo, American redstart and the hooded warbler. Because the woodland area is such a good habitat for nesting neo-tropical birds, the park district took great care in the development of access trails to minimize the disturbance of potential nesting sites on the property. The month of May is the prime time to see the greatest variety of birds.
