



# Medina County Park District is now operating the Susan Hambley Nature Center in Brunswick

The park district recently entered into an agreement with the city of Brunswick to operate the Susan Hambley Nature Center at Brunswick Lake. It is located near the Brunswick Buehler's store on Center Road. The facility was built two years ago with a grant from the State of Ohio. The park district had been discussing the potential use of the site for programs since it opened.

The nature center is named in memory of Brunswick resident and councilwoman Susan Hambley, wife of County Commissioner Steve Hambley. During her lifetime, Susan was an inspiration to all as she battled Muscular Dystrophy while remaining very active in community affairs. Susan passed away in 2008. She was a long-time supporter of the park district.

The park district will operate the center in accordance with a five-year lease agreement recently approved by both the city council and the park district's board of commissioners. The Interpretive Department will be responsible for the center. The city will assist with the operation by providing cleaning services as well as being responsible for the utility costs for the building.
