Trekking Through Autumn is a self-guided hiking program. Come and discover the beauty of autumn in the Medina County parks. Participants who hike at least 12 of the 13 designated trails (listed on the back) will receive an award. Hikes must be completed from September 1 through November 30. All parks are open from dawn until dark.

Receiving Your Award

Backpacks are awarded the first year, and hiking pins will be awarded for successive years. Awards are free for all Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$2 for a hiking pin. Call 330-722-9364 with questions.
