



A Self-Guided Hiking Program

Get out and explore your Medina County parks during the 14th annual Trekking through Autumn program!

Participants who hike eight or more of the designated trails between September 1 and November 30 will receive an award. All parks are open from 6 a.m. until dark with the exception of the grounds at Wolf Creek Environmental Center. Please note the building at Wolf Creek Environmental Center is currently closed until further notice, but the grounds are open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday. Please check www.MedinaCountyParks.com for changes to that schedule.

First-year hikers earn a backpack, and veteran hikers earn a pin. **Pins are not available for first-year hikers.** Awards are free for Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$3 for a hiking pin.

Completed forms must be turned in by February 28, 2021 to receive the award. There is a drop-off bin outside the park office, or you can mail in completed forms to:
