



Get out and explore your Medina County parks during the 15th annual Trekking through Autumn program!

Participants who hike eight or more of the designated trails between September 1 and November 30 will receive an award. All parks are open from dawn until dark except Oenslager Nature Center, which is open Tuesday-Saturday from 9-5 and Sunday 12-5.

First-year hikers earn a backpack, and veteran hikers earn a pin. Pins are not available for first-year hikers. Awards are free for all Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$3 for the hiking pin.

To claim your award, bring completed forms to Oenslager Nature Center at 6100 Ridge Rd. (Rt. 94) in Sharon Township (use Wadsworth 44281 for GPS). Deadline for receiving awards is December 17, 2021.
