



Get out and explore your Medina County parks during the 17th annual Trekking through Autumn program!

Participants who hike eight or more of the designated trails between September 1 and November 30 will receive an award. All parks are open from dawn until one hour past sunset.

First-year hikers earn a backpack, and veteran hikers earn a pin. *Pins are not available for first-year hikers.* Awards are free for Medina County residents. Out-of-county residents and Hinckley residents pay \$10 for the backpack and \$3 for the hiking pins.

Bring completed forms by December 17, 2023 to Oenslager Nature Center to claim your award (while supplies last). Nature center hours are Tuesday through Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Sunday from 12 to 5 p.m.
