The descriptions of terrain are self-reported or based on observations by the Medina County Fall Foliage Tour planning committee and are intended to provide general information for accessibility considerations. This list is not a complete description of each site and accuracy may vary.

Geig's Orchard	No	Yes	Yes	No	A gravel and pavement parking area lead to the storefront and displays. Access to the orchards is across dirt and gravel farm roads as well as lawn.
Seville Library	Yes	No	Yes	No	Street parking is available and additional public parking lots are located about a block away from the library. Accessible public restroom available.
Seville Historical Society	Yes	Yes	Yes	Yes	Three steps up into the building.
Rupp-Dale Farm	Yes	Yes	No	No	Chopped corn stubble field parking.
Sky Park	No	No	Yes	No	Restrooms are located on the first floor and are wheelchair accessible. There are no stairs to enter the first floor of the building but there are stairs up to the second floor of the building.
Trolley Line Park	No	No	Yes	No	Parking area connected to asphalt trail. Trolley Line House is handicap accessible with an indoor restroom.

Oenslager Nature Center	Yes	Yes	Yes	No	A sidewalk with slight downward slope is present between the parking lot and building; the paved trail also slopes downhill to program area; some paths are grass, while others may contain a combo of grass, gravel or dirt.
Barn Talk Hops	Yes	Yes	Yes	No	Parking area and hops growing area on grass. A gravel drive leads to the barn.
Mound Hill Cemetery	Yes	No	Yes	No	A paved driveway circles the cemetery.
Sharon Center United Methodist Church	No	Yes	Yes	Yes	Accessible parking is behind the church. If you enter through the back door, an elevator is available to access the main and lower floors.
