Natural Discoveries Hiking Series

Natural Discoveries is an award-based series of free nature programs designed for ages seven to adult. Themed hikes are held on Sundays, and hikes that explore seasonal happenings are offered on Wednesdays. No pre-registration is required.

First-time participants who complete ten (10) hikes in a calendar year earn a wooden hiking staff (one time only). For each year that five (5) hikes in a calendar year are completed, participants will earn a completion patch. Awards are free for Medina County residents. Non-residents pay \$15 for a hiking stick and \$3 for a patch.

Hikers can claim awards by presenting their forms to the naturalist leading the program to demonstrate eligibility. All awards must be claimed by December 22, 2023.

All Sunday hikes begin at 3 p.m.

Spring Wildflowers

Dragonflies

Moss

Mosses are things that stay in the background, but if you pay attention, they are in the background nearly everywhere you

look. Bring mosses into focus as we hike along learning some basics of moss biology and how to distinguish some of the common moss groups.

Trees

Butterflies

There are 137 species of butterflies and skippers recorded in Ohio. Which species do we find in our

parks? We'll learn about the common and not so common butterflies found at Killbuck Lakes and talk about the volunteer butterfly surveys being done in several of the county parks to monitor area butterfly populations.

Animal Architects
