Responsibility

Under the direction of the Land Manager, assists with duties pertaining to natural resource management

Examples of Duties

- Nature trail construction and maintenance
- Aquatic management projects
- Tree maintenance projects
- Park maintenance activities
- Operation of mowing equipment, chain saws, tractors and trucks
- Supervision of other seasonal employees working on natural resource projects
- Wildlife survey work (i.e. bluebird nests, wood duck nests, etc.)
- Assists the land manager with natural resource management planning

Necessary Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Must be enrolled in an accredited college or university and have some experience with equipment operation.

Required Physical Abilities Include the Following, But Are Not Limited To

- 1.) Must occasionally lift items in excess of 50 pounds.
- 2.) Must work in the outdoors in inclement weather.
- 3.) Must occasionally work around heavy equipment during construction projects.
- 4.) Hard physical labor is required.

Desired Training and Experience Requirements
